Colleague Support for new and acting headteachers

One of the priorities for EPHA for the year ahead is the development of a Colleague Support system, particularly for new and acting headteachers. EPHA already identifies and contacts new heads each term, but we aim to establish a group of colleagues who can offer structured support to a new head. The Professional Officer plans to

- produce a job description for the Colleague Support role, with suggested actions over a period of time;
- develop a directory of headteachers who are prepared to offer this support, recompensed by EPHA to ensure a professional and consistent service;
- provide a model induction pack that headteacher groups could personalise and use.

We would welcome your ideas about what will make this service effective and valuable, and what are the critical things that a new head needs to ensure that they feel supported and informed in their role.
